Property Details The impressive façade of this historic home immediately draws you in. Large Andalusian wooden double doors open into a grand entrance hall with high vaulted ceilings. A second set of wooden doors with decorative ironwork leads you into the main hallway, where an elegant turning staircase ascends to the upper floors. To the right, a formal lounge features a magnificent original fireplace with ornate plaster mouldings. This leads to a second reception room, which opens onto the inner courtyard. From there, a third adjoining room also enjoys courtyard access—creating a versatile flow ideal for entertaining or guest accommodation. On the left side of the hallway are two additional rooms, perfect for conversion into a study, library, or further living spaces. The staircase itself is a beautiful feature, adorned with traditional tiling and a simple yet stylish balustrade. The first floor offers several bedrooms, some with access to an elevated terrace, evoking a truly romantic, old-world charm. On the top floor, a large attic space provides a blank canvas—ideal for creating a studio, additional bedroom, or private retreat. The Bodega has a separate access and sits to side under the property. This property has been used for Film Festivals in the past and Legend says that Napolians Brother and Cervants once stayed in this property.
